End of Year Checklist for Parents:

- __ Check the Lost & Found for items that belong to your family (do this before the last day of school)
- __ Notify the office of your intent to return if you haven't already (extra forms in the office)
- __ If your child has medication at school, please pick it up on the last day (this will save us from calling you!)
- __ Negative hot lunch balances need to be paid by the last day of school. Any extra money in their account will be transferred to the next school year.
- __ Make arrangements for your child to be picked up at early dismissal on the last day of school. Last day is TUESDAY, June 7th and dismissal is at 11:50 for the entire school. (Hot lunch will be served at 11:00 am. There will be no supervision after dismissal time.
- __ **First Day of School is Thursday, Aug 18th 2011.** Your child needs to be in class on this day in order to keep their place on the roster.

Keep this in mind when making travel plans.

Last Day of School, Tuesday, June 7th... The schedule for all students will be 8:30-11:50 a.m. Lunch recess will be held from 11:00-11:30 for primary students and 11:10-11:40 for upper grade students. **Please make sure you have provided appropriate transportation for your child that day. Our staff will not be available to supervise children after dismissal time at 11:50 a.m.**

If your child has medication in the school office, please pick it up on the last day of school, tomorrow, Tuesday, June 7th between 8:15 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Any medication that remains after the close of school will be discarded.

The 2011-2012 school year will begin on August 18, 2011. A tentative list of classes will be posted the day before school on Wednesday, August 17th after 4:00 p.m. A kindergarten "Welcome Walk Through" will also be held on the 17th from 2:00-4:00 p.m. Our PTA will be on hand with juice and cookies.

STATE PRESCHOOL ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

The Child Development Centers (CDC), in partnership with the Cupertino Union School District, is currently taking applications for its free State Preschool Program for the Fall of 2011. The program, which serves low-income three- and four-year-old children, is located at Sedgwick Elementary School, 19200 Phil Lane in Cupertino. Children who will be three or four-years-old by Dec. 2 may qualify. Priority is given to children who will be four by Dec. 2, 2011.

This free, parent participation preschool offers children many exciting learning experiences including math, pre-reading, science and creative arts, as well as the opportunity to work and play in group situations. Preschool activities are designed to help children make a successful transition to kindergarten. Children attend three hours per day, five days a week.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Summer Registration

Registration will continue at the home school sites through June 17, 2011. After this date, registration will be shifted to the Cupertino Union School District Office, Student Assignment Department from June 20 through August 12, 2011. The District Office is located at 10301 Vista Drive in Cupertino, and will be open for registration from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Due to increased enrollment across the District, space is not guaranteed at home school. The District does guarantee a space at an overflow school within the District.

Change of Residence

Please be aware that parents/guardians are required to notify the school site or the District Office of a change in residency within 10 days of moving. Parents/guardians may complete a Request for Transfer form at the time the change of residence is submitted if they wish to remain at the current school site. Approvals are based on adequate space availability and there are no guarantees that a student may continue at the current school site. All other Request for Transfer forms will be available on August 10, 2011 at the school of choice.

Important Attendance Policy reminder

Students who leave early before the last day of school will be placed on the registration priority list after any students registering in the spring. If the number of neighborhood students exceeds capacity at the school site, students will be designated to an overflow school site until space becomes available at the home school.
